Dear Resident:

On Fish Day, July 19 2014, street parking will be restricted in the following areas:

1. The east side of N. Montgomery St. from W. Jackson St. to W. Dodge St.
2. The east side of N. Milwaukee St. from W. Grand Ave. to W. Dodge St.
3. The east side of N. Harrison St. from W. Jackson St. to W. Dodge St.
4. The north side of W. Jackson St. from N. Harrison St. to N. Webster St.
5. The north side of W. Van Buren St. from N. Wisconsin St. to N. Webster St.
6. The north side of W. Dodge St. from N. Milwaukee St. to N. Montgomery St.
7. Both sides of W Chestnut from S. Wisconsin to S. Park.
8. Both sides of E. Whitefish Rd. from N. Wisconsin St. to E. Walters St.
9. Both sides of E. Walters St. from N. Wisconsin St. to E. Whitefish Rd.
10. Both sides of E. Douglas St. from N. Wisconsin through the circle.
11. Both sides of E. Cleveland St. from N. Wisconsin St. to N. Lakeview Ave.
12. Both sides of E. Prospect St. from N. Wisconsin St to the end of the road.
13. Both sides of N. Lakeview Ave. from E. Prospect St. to E. Whitefish Rd.

**The parking restrictions imposed will be: No parking will be allowed July 19, 2014, at 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 midnight. This area will be posted and the restrictions will be enforced.**

The reasons for these restrictions are the number of vehicles parked in these areas, before, during and after the parade, which makes it very difficult for the necessary movement of emergency vehicles. Furthermore, street construction in the area of the PWHS requires the use of W Chestnut during the parade for shuttle bus traffic.

It is requested that all residents comply with this temporary parking restriction on that date by parking their vehicles off the street completely or in an area not affected by the restrictions. We also request that you pass this information on to any out-of-town guest(s) that you might have that day.
