Dear Resident:

On Fish Day, July 19, 2014 parking on the street will be restricted on Hales Trail from the north entrance of the upper lake park north to the bike path. The restrictions being that, there will be no parking on both sides of Hales Trail from the north entrance to the park to Sunrise Drive and from Sunrise Drive north to the bike path, parking will only be allowed on the west side of the street.

The parking restrictions imposed will be: No parking will be allowed in the above area from July 19, 2014, at 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 midnight. This area will be posted and the restrictions will be enforced.

The reasons for these restrictions are the number of vehicles parked in this area before, during and after the "Fish Day Festival" makes it very difficult for the necessary movement of emergency vehicles.

It is requested that all residents comply with this temporary parking restriction on that date by parking their vehicles off the street completely or in an area not affected by the restriction. We also request that you pass this information on to any out-of-town guests that you might have that day.
