- **Personal care products (shampoo, lotion, etc.)**
- **Household hazardous waste (paint, cleaners, batteries)**

- **Expired & unwanted prescription medications**
- **Veterinary medications**
- **Over-the-counter medications**
- **Medicated liquids, creams, ointments**
