Re: Stanford Street Emergency Water Main Replacement
Street Reconstruction

Dear Resident:

On Monday, November 2, TP Concrete Inc., will begin work on replacing the concrete curb and gutter on Stanford St. Because the new concrete requires 7 – 10 days of curing time, **PLEASE HAVE ALL VEHICLES WHICH YOU INTEND TO USE IN THE NEXT 2 WEEKS OUT OF YOUR DRIVEWAY/GARAGE BY 6:30 AM ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4.** Cars may be parked on any side street during this period. Please do not park on your block of Stanford St. during this time. All new curb and driveway approach replacement should be completed by November 6, with street removal and repaving completed the following week. The schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.

Lawns will be restored after the street is paved, with grass emerging in late May/early June of next year. Weeds that emerge with the seed can be controlled with regular mowing. Herbicides should not be used until the lawn has been mowed at least four to six times.

Street trees will be re-planted in the Spring to replace those removed recently due to infestation by the Emerald Ash Borer.

Please set out your garbage and recycling carts on the normal pick-up day unless otherwise instructed.

Please refrain from raking leaves into the street until the street is repaved.
