Re: Stanford Street Emergency Water Main Replacement

Dear Resident:

On Monday, October 12, Heartland Construction, Inc., will begin replacing the water main and services in the 1000 block of N. Stanford St. Weather permitting, this work should be completed by October 23. It is anticipated that there will be two water service interruptions during construction for which you will receive notice on the day prior. Each interruption should be less than four hours unless unforeseen circumstances arise.

After completion of the water main work, contractors will begin reconstruction of the road. Additional information on that schedule will follow, although it is expected that work on the road will be completed by the end of November. There will be no special assessments for this work.

Lawns will be restored by dormant seeding, with grass emerging in late May/early June of next year. Weeds that emerge with the seed can be controlled with regular mowing. Herbicides should not be used until the lawn has been mowed at least four to six times.

Street trees will be re-planted in the Spring to replace those removed recently due to infestation by the Emerald Ash Borer.

Please do not park on the street during the week days.

Please set out your garbage and recycling carts on the normal pick-up day unless otherwise instructed.

The City will collect leaves at 7 am on Monday mornings during construction. Please rake leaves into the street on weekends, refraining from raking leaves into the street during the week.
