## Public Information Meeting scheduled for 2019 Street Improvements

### Proposed Improvement

The City of Port Washington is proposing the following design improvements in 2019:

Crocker Avenue	Grand Avenue	Melin Street	Design Only

Garfield Avenue	Second Avenue	Fourth Avenue	Watermain and Street
Third Avenue	Alley	Garfield Avenue	Watermain and Street
Western Ave/Ravine St	Division Street	Oakland Avenue	Watermain Only

The proposed project consists of storm sewer improvements, water main re-lays, reconstructing the existing roadway, and spot replacement of existing sidewalk. Information on design proposals affecting street/terrace widths will also be provided. No right-of-way acquisition is anticipated. There will be no special assessments. Additionally, homeowners interested in replacing their sanitary sewer lateral or constructing a new storm sewer connection as part of this project may arrange to do so at their expense by contacting the City Engineer. These streets will be closed to through-traffic during construction, and homeowners will be notified of the construction schedule once it becomes available.

### Please attend

All persons interested in this project are encouraged to attend a **Public Information Meeting on Tuesday, December 4, 2018. The meeting will be held from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. in the upper level of City Hall, 100 West Grand Avenue.** The meeting will be conducted in an open house format. There will be no formal presentation, so you may arrive at any time between 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm. The facility is wheelchair accessible.

### Information available

Representatives from the City of Port Washington and Gremmer & Associates, Inc. (design consultant) will be available to explain the proposed improvements while gathering information, listening to concerns, and answering questions of those in attendance. Maps showing the proposed improvements will be on display and additional information on the project will be available for attendees to take home.
