

**City of Port Washington Police and Fire Commission
Minutes of Regular Meeting Held Monday July 12, 2010**

1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. Present: Commissioners Nelson, B. Becker, Taucher, Tietzen, and M. Becker; Police Chief Thomas; Fire Chief Mitchell.
2. There were no public appearances. A citizen, Candace Fettig, has been in touch with Commissioner Nelson and the Police Department regarding an incident in her apartment complex. The police are continuing to investigate.
3. The minutes of the regular meeting held on June 14, 2010 were reviewed. Moved by Tietzen, seconded by B. Becker to approve. Unanimous approval.

Ambulance Department

1. Ambulance Department bills for June 2010 were reviewed. Moved by B. Becker, seconded by Tietzen to approve. Unanimous approval.
2. The ambulance budget was reviewed.
3. Ambulance revenue for June 2010 was \$20,177.29. The year-to-date total is \$132,670.52.
4. June 2010 ambulance calls were reviewed.
5. Other business: the process of upgrading to the Paramedic service level is proceeding. The public hearing will be held prior to the PFC meeting on September 13.

Fire Department

1. Fire Department bills for June 2010 were reviewed. Moved by B. Becker, seconded by Taucher to approve. Unanimous approval.
2. The fire department budget was reviewed.
3. June 2010 fire calls were reviewed.
4. There was no Fire Chief's report.
5. There was no other Fire Department business.

Police Department

1. Police Department bills for June 2010 were reviewed. Moved by B. Becker, seconded by Taucher to approve. Unanimous approval.
2. Municipal Court income for May 2010 was \$6,798.56. The year-to-date total is \$48,299.95.
3. Chief's Report
 - a. Accreditation: The WILEAG board will review and act on the assessment team report at their meeting on July 23. Chief Thomas, Captain Keller and several Commissioners will attend the meeting.
 - b. The department initiative to increase compliance with the city's animal ordinances continues. Signs explaining the regulations have been placed in city parks, on the Interurban Trail and at the beach. Fourteen citations were issued in June.
4. Three press releases were issued:
 - a. Lt. Barbuch graduated from the Executive Management Program.
 - b. Police Clerk Becki Hill completed the Crime Analyst training program.
 - c. The PD Honor Guard presented the colors at the June 27 Milwaukee Brewers game.
5. There was no other Police Department business.
6. Moved by Tietzen, second by M. Becker to adjourn. Unanimous approval. Meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
