1. Roll Call- Members present Alderman Ehrlich, Alderman Neumyer, Alderman Becker, Police Chief Kevin Hingiss and City Engineer Rob Vanden Noven. Also present was the City Administrator Mark Grams.
2. Elect Chairman and Vice Chairman- Motion made by Alderman Neumyer, seconded by Alderman Ehrlich to nominate Rob Vanden Noven as Committee Chairperson and Kevin Hingiss as Vice Chairperson. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Approve Minutes Of Previous Meeting- Motion made by Alderman Becker, seconded by Alderman Neumyer to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Discuss Improving Safety Of N. Franklin Street / Jackson Street Intersection- The Committee reviewed the reports from the Police Department regarding the number of accidents at this intersection. The number was not unusual compared to other intersections in the downtown area. The Committee did discuss safety alternatives for this intersection, but none seemed to be ideal. It was the Committee's consensus to not do anything to this intersection at this time.
