TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

1. Roll Call- Members present were Aldermen Mike Ehrlich, Dan Becker and Paul Neumyer, Chief Kevin Hingiss, City Engineer Rob Vanden Noven and City Administrator Mark Grams.
2. Approve Minutes Of Previous Meeting- None.
3. Consider No Parking In Front Of Anita Gardens On Johnson Street- Motion made by Alderman Becker, seconded by Alderman Ehrlich to approve no parking from east side of driveway to Westside of walkway on Johnson Street. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Consider Speed Limit And Parking Restrictions For Road In Coal Dock Park- The Committee discussed the option of a one-way road with parking on the street or two-way with no parking. With no conclusion reached, the Committee tabled for further discussion at the next meeting.
5. Request For “Slow, Children Caution Sign- After discussion of the Committee, it was a consensus to have curve/speed sign installed on Pierre Lane at the curve, south of Orchard Lane.
6. Review Signage Near High School- The City Engineer will work with the high school if any signage needs to be changed.
7. Consider No Parking On A Portion Of Van Buren Street- Motion made by Alderman Becker, seconded by Alderman Neumyer to approve the No Parking on Van Buren Street as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
8. Consider Change To 15 Minute Parking Times In Front Of Sweet Buns On W. Grand Avenue- Motion made by Alderman Ehrlich, seconded by Alderman Becker to approve the 15 Minute Parking time change in front of Sweet Buns on W. Grand Avenue as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
9. Consider No Parking On A Portion Of Pierre Lane West Of North Wisconsin Street- Motion made by Alderman Neumyer, seconded by Alderman Ehrlich for No Parking on northside from Wisconsin Street to 1st driveway on Pierre Lane. Motion carried unanimously.
10. Any Other Business That May Properly Come Before The Committee- None.
