1. Roll Call- Members present were Aldermen Mike Ehrlich, Paul Neumyer, Dan Becker (arrived at 4:39 p.m.). Also present was City Engineer Rob Vanden Noven, Police Chief Kevin Hingiss and City Administrator Mark Grams.
2. Approve Minutes Of Previous Meeting- Motion made by Alderman Ehrlich, seconded by Kevin Hingiss to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Ordinance 2014-15 (Parking Restrictions In Park And Ride Lot On Seven Hills Road)- Motion made by Alderman Ehrlich, seconded by Alderman Neumyer to recommend approval by Common Council of Ordinance 2015-15 Parking Restrictions In Park And Ride Lot On Seven Hills Road as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Ordinance 2014-16 (Approve Angle Parking On The Northside Of E. Main Street, East Of Franklin Street)- Motion made by Alderman Ehrlich, seconded by Alderman Neumyer to recommend approval of Ordinance 2014-16 Approve Angle Parking On The Northside Of E. Main Street, East Of Franklin Street as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
5. Discuss Angle Parking And Making S. Webster Street One Way South Of Foster Street- Discussion was held on different options looked at; past public meetings included local residents objecting to a one way street.
6. Discuss Jackson And Franklin Street Intersection- Discussion was held, the large planters will be moved first to improve visibility.
7. Discuss Parking Restriction For Parking Lot Behind Duluth Trading And The North Slip Parking Lot- This item will be reviewed next year, the charter captains should be parking in the north slip lot.
8. Discuss No Parking On Holden Street Near Middle School Field- Discussion was held and the youth groups will be contacted to inform their parents to be cautious when dropping their children off and as they cross the street.
9. Any Other Business That May Properly Come Before The Committee- Discussion was held on whether there is a stop sign needed at S. Division and Western due to the speed of drivers in that area.
