1. Roll Call- Members present were Aldermen Dan Becker, Bill Driscoll and Kevin Rudser. Also present was City Administrator Mark Grams.
2. Approve Minutes Of Previous Meeting- Motion made by Alderman Rudser, seconded by Alderman Driscoll to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Motion To Go Into Closed Session According To Wisconsin State Statute 19.85 (1)(c) To Discuss Police Union Labor Negotiations DPW Union Wages For 2014 And On Call (Standby) Pay For Paramedics- Motion made by Alderman Rudser, seconded by Alderman Driscoll to go into closed session for the reasons stated above. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Becker, Rudser and Driscoll. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Reconvene Into Open Session-The Committee reconvened into open session at 6:32 p.m.
5. Possible Action of Any Item Discussed In Closed Session- Motion made by Alderman Driscoll, seconded by Alderman Rudser to approve the proposed wage schedule for DPW Union employees, wage increase for Paramedics on standby 2% (\$5.10 per hour) and grant the Senior Center Assistant a 2% wage increase retroactive to her 6 month anniversary date. Motion carried unanimously.
