

New Brush Policy for 2018

Brush piles that are estimated to exceed 15 minutes of chipping will be eligible to be disposed of by “hauling away”. For example, brush in the parkway that is stacked 5 feet high and longer than 15 feet.

It is important to properly stack brush with butt ends facing the curb in the direction of traffic and to separate logs and brush. If possible, stack brush in smaller individual piles that will allow for “grab and go” in order to be carried to the chipper. If eligible for “hauling away” you will be notified with a letter informing you that you will be charged before the work is performed and a bill will be sent. We will do our best to not charge and assist in informing of the proper way to stack brush so we can be more efficient.

The charge rate is \$60 if “hauled away”. All normal chipping is still free. Also if you have smaller piles that can be put in containers for an example; clear bags or plastic tubs, it would be much appreciated to make the process more efficient.
