

## **BRUSH COLLECTION**

Curbside brush collection will resume in mid-April and end in October. Brush should be placed in the parkway or by the curb for pickup.

Brush can no longer be brought to the Street Department Yard. Collection will be on a weekly basis. All brush shall be placed at the curb or adjacent to the sidewalk in accordance with the following:

1. All brush shall be less than 8" in diameter with all branches exceeding 1" in diameter removed from the main limb.
2. Brush shall be left in the longest manageable length but not greater than 12'.
3. Brush shall be neatly stacked, with all butt ends in the same direction in a manner to make it easily collected and shall be directly accessible from the street, alley or sidewalk. City employees will not go on to private property to collect brush.
4. Special collection fees may be imposed for collections exceeding 15 minutes.
5. Stumps may be taken to the Street Yard.

## **YARD WASTE/BRUSH COLLECTION**

The Street Yard is located at 333 N. Moore Road. The Street Yard is open starting the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday in April through 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in December.

The Street Department Yard will be open for the disposal of yard waste on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3 p.m. – 6 p.m., and Saturdays from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

The Street Department Yard will be closed from December through March.

## **GRASS CLIPPINGS LEAVES AND GARDEN WASTES**

Grass clippings, leaves, and garden waste can be composted in your yard (the preferred method) or brought to the Street Dept. yard located at 333 N. Moore Rd. for proper disposal.

These items cannot be disposed of with normal household refuse, and will not be picked up by the private contractor.

## **LEAF PICKUP**

Leaves can be raked into the gutter in late October and November for the City Crew to collect. Do not rake leaves, grass clippings, or any other debris into the gutter at any other time of the year.
