This excludes active military, permanent overseas and indefinitely confined persons. An acceptable PHOTO ID for voting does not have to include a current address. ID Card Issued by Federally Recognized WI Tribe	—Expired or unexpired	Care Facility Contract or Intake Document	—Must indicate voter resides at facility —Is not required to indicate room number
