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## Public Information Meeting scheduled for 2017 Street Improvements

### Proposed transportation improvement

The City of Port Washington is proposing to improve the following streets and alleys in 2017:

<b>Harrison St:</b>	Jackson St. – Dodge St.
<b>Dodge St.:</b>	Webster St. – Wisconsin St.
<b>Pierre Lane:</b>	200' west of Montgomery St. – Wisconsin St.
<b>Montgomery St.:</b>	Dodge St.-Walters St.
<b>Walters St.:</b>	Holden St. – Wisconsin St.
<b>Holden St.:</b>	Walters St. – Jefferson St.
<b>Alley 1</b>	Between Webster/Montgomery/Dodge/Van Buren
<b>Alley 2</b>	Between Milwaukee/Wisconsin/Walters/Pierre

The proposed project consists of reconstructing the existing roadway, spot replacement of existing sidewalk, construction of new sidewalk where it is currently absent, water main replacement, and storm and sanitary sewer improvements. Information on design proposals affecting street/terrace widths will also be provided. No right-of-way acquisition is anticipated. There will be no special assessments with the exception of new (not replacement) sidewalk located on a property's front side. Additionally, homeowners interested in replacing their sanitary sewer lateral or constructing a new storm sewer connection as part of this project may arrange to do so at their expense by contacting the City Engineer. These streets will be closed to through-traffic during construction, and homeowners will be notified of the construction schedule once it becomes available.

### Please attend

All persons interested in this project are encouraged to attend a **Public Information Meeting on Tuesday, December 6, 2016. The meeting will be held from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. in the upper level of City Hall, 100 West Grand Avenue.** The meeting will be conducted in an open house format, however, a brief public presentation will be made at 5:15 pm. The facility is wheelchair accessible.

### Information available

Representatives from the City of Port Washington and Gremmer & Associates, Inc. (design consultant) will be available to explain the proposed improvements while gathering information and listening to any questions or concerns of those in attendance. Maps showing the proposed improvements will be on display, and additional information on the project will be available for attendees to take home.
