

**CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 2016-12**

Relating to Membership of the Parks and Recreation Board

The Common Council of the City of Port Washington, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:


Section 1. Section 2.12.030 A. of the Municipal Code of the City of Port Washington, relating to membership of the Parks and Recreation Board, is hereby amended to read as follows:


- A. How Constituted. This board shall consist of not less than nine nor more than eleven residents of the City, two of whom shall be aldermen and the remainder of whom shall be citizen members. All appointments to the Board shall be made by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Common Council. The term of office of the aldermen members shall be one year. The term of office of the citizen members shall be three years. All terms of office will commence on the third Tuesday in April. In addition, the Mayor may annually appoint up to two students who are 16 years of age or older and enrolled at Port Washington High School at the beginning of their terms to serve as non-voting advisors to the Board, subject to confirmation by the Council. The term of appointment of student advisors shall be for one year, commencing in July.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
