

A PROCLAMATION HONORING

JUDE BROBST

WHEREAS, Jude Brobst, a member of the Cedarburg High School swim and dive team, was walking in the area of Coal Dock Park when his attention was drawn by the cries for help of an individual who had fallen into the harbor and was unable to swim.

WHEREAS, upon approaching the scene, Jude Brobst discovered that Ben Kasdorf, a certified lifeguard who had also been walking in the area had already jumped into the harbor and was attempting to keep the stricken individual afloat.

WHEREAS, Jude Brobst then entered the harbor waters to assist Kasdorf with keeping the victim afloat until rescue assistance provided by the Port Washington Police Department and the Fire Department Dive and Rescue Team arrived and assisted in safely and successfully removing the three individuals from the water.

WHEREAS, Jude Brobst took direct, immediate, and positive action to preserve the life of another human being who was in danger of dying.

WHEREAS, through his prompt and alert actions and with some degree of hazard to his own life and safety, he prevented the loss of a human life.

WHEREAS, the circumstances of this selfless act were such, that any delay in providing assistance would have, in all probability, resulted in the person's death.
